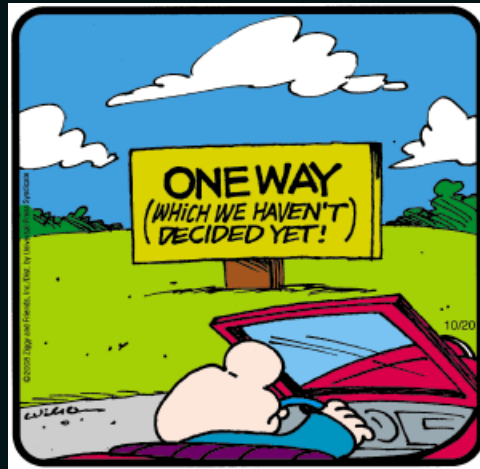


Monday August 18, 2014
