Eventually we got situated properly. Our patio faces the back of park models that have beautiful landscaping and lots of solar lights.






## Tuesday November 2, 2010

### Monday November 15, 2010


Maureen went for Orientation to learn the ins and outs of being a Park Host. She will help welcome people and answer their questions.
