Today there was no delay and we had a


oops!

The girls and Percy took a pleasant hike into the forest and out onto the beach.




Gaylene cooked a fabulous Easter meal; turkey and all the trimmings.

Saturday April 10, 2010




Percy is more interested in sniffing than checking out the water.
